Dear Church Family and Friends,

Mt. Everest has been in the news a lot lately. It is the tallest mountain in the world, standing at 29,029 feet. Eleven climbers died recently. One cause was a traffic jam of climbers in a section where they had to go almost single file.

This section, near the summit of Mt. Everest, is in what is called the “Death Zone” (from 26,000 feet to the top). Climbers in the “Death Zone” deteriorate quickly both mentally and physically. The goal is to get through the “Death Zone” as quickly as possible. Otherwise, death from altitude sickness is a real possibility.

So, climbers who needed to get out of that zone had to wait and wait, knowing that every minute could mean life or death. Many climbers knew about this danger before embarking on the last leg of their climb. However, because of their desire to reach the top, they ignored the risks. It cost them their lives.

Our world is in its own “Death Zone”. Because priorities are on the wrong things, spiritual risks are often ignored. It is a matter of life and death...forever.

We have a message for the world about life - eternal life. Jesus said in John 10:10, “I have come that they might have life and have it to the full.” The moment someone asks Jesus into their heart they cross over from the Death Zone to the Life Zone!






