Dear Church Family and Friends,

God has wired our personalities in a certain way. When we discover our personality type, it helps us work with our personality, rather than against it. This knowledge also helps us work better with others.

Each personality type has upsides and downsides. We can learn to maximize our upsides and minimize our downsides.

When we know Jesus, our personality type does not change. It is redeemed. God can work through us in new ways.

The Enneagram identifies nine personality types. Which one is most like you? Get someone else's opinion of your type, too. Remember, no type is better than the other. Our churches and world need them all.

- The Perfectionist** – needs to live in the right way: improving themselves & the world around them. At best: reliable. At worst: inflexible.
- The Helper** – needs to be loved & valued & to express their care for others. At best: caring. At worst: give in too much.
- The Achiever** – needs to achieve success & avoid failure. At best: confident. At worst: self-centered.
- The Romantic** – needs to experience their feelings, be understood, search for the meaning of life and avoid being ordinary. At best: passionate. At worst: needy.
- The Thinker** – needs to know and understand everything, be self-sufficient, & avoid looking foolish. At best: wise. At worst: distant.
- The Questioner** – needs security. At best: honest. At worst: sarcastic.
- The Adventurer** – needs to be happy, plan enjoyable activities, contribute to the world & avoid pain. At best: enthusiastic. At worst: impulsive.
- The Challenger** – needs to be self-reliant, strong, & avoid feeling weak and dependent. At best: direct. At worst: domineering.
- The Peacemaker** – needs to keep the peace, merge with others & to avoid conflict. At best: diplomatic. At worst: unassertive.

Over the next few weeks, I will explore each personality type. I will also illustrate each type with a different Bible character. Identify your type and the type of people around you.




Night in Bethlehem!




